Achieving Competent Communicator and Competent Leader may be **both** accomplished very efficiently. Toastmasters work together to learn and refine important skills. The various awards are designed to help you know when you have arrived at defined milestones and to tell the world that you have arrived, too.

Simply **plan ahead** to make many of the roles that you performs for your club count toward your Competent Leader award. Just look at the requirements and ask someone to give you **a written evaluation every time** you do a qualifying activity.

The CL manual “Project Matrix” looks daunting until you read each project. This chart shows how easily you can accomplish all the tasks. Some projects only require doing one task out of five – and you probably were going to do those tasks anyway.

This chart is intended to help you plan and record your progress. The CL manual spells out the details of each task for the projects that you are expected to take into account as you grow as a competent leader. Note that the projects add specific goals to achieve while performing the role. That means that as a speech evaluator, you will add to your skills each time that you evaluate!

Remember that your CL manual has all the details that make the projects valuable learning tools.

Enjoy doing both CC and CL together.
